

# VISITING RULES BIRTH AND POSTPARTUM CARE

- There is no general mask wearing requirement in the patient room, with close accompaniment of patients outside the patient's room and also when accompanying patients to consultation hours, examinations (e.g. x-rays) or therapies. A mask can be worn if desired. Cloth masks are not permitted.
- Visitors with **symptoms of coronavirus infection and/or proven coronavirus infection** must wear a mask. A mask must also still be worn for direct contact with immunocompromised patients or droplet-isolated patients.
- Visitors with **symptoms of coronavirus infection and/or proven coronavirus infection** are generally advised to postpone their visit.
- A **partner/husband** may be present **during the birth** and can visit during **regular visiting hours**. Siblings are allowed to visit the mother and newborn after the birth. All patients are allowed **to receive additional visitors in addition to their partner/husband and siblings** from the first day of hospitalization.
