

# INFORMATION ABOUT THE VISITING BAN

In the Andreasklinik Cham Zug the visiting ban still applies. We consider this step to be right and important in order to keep the risk of transmission as low as possible.

**In the following cases exceptions do apply:**

- Patients with a stay of more than three nights may receive a named person for a visit once a day after the third night. Visiting hours are limited to a maximum of three hours per day during regular visiting hours.
- In the case of pregnant women/birthlings/parents who have recently given birth, the partner may be present during the birth as well as visiting during the regular visiting hours.
- Parents of children under the age of 16 may visit at any time, provided the patient is in a single room or in a shared room with other children under the age of 16.
- Patients in palliative situations may receive named persons for visit from the first day. The visiting hours and the number of visitors are arranged individually.

Visitors must register and deregister at the entrance control. A hygiene mask will be handed in. Visitors with symptoms of illness as defined by the FOPH may not visit patients.
