

# VISITING REGULATIONS: BIRTH AND CHILDBED

For our expectant mothers and women in childbed the following regulation applies:

- The **partner/husband** may be present **during the birth** as well as visit according to **regular visiting hours**.
- The **siblings** are allowed to visit the mother and the newborn from the first day. We ask you to limit the visit of the children to a **maximum of two hours per day**.
- Visitors are required to **wear a mask** - even in the patient's room. Children from the age of twelve are also obliged to wear a mask, between six and twelve years of age we recommend mouth and nose protection. A mouth and nose protection is provided free of charge at the clinic entrance. Fabric masks are not allowed.
- The partner/husband must leave his or her **personal details** (including those of the children) on a form in the patient's room and hand it out to the nursing staff.
- **Double room:** If the room neighbor agrees and the distance of 1.5 metres can be kept, the visit of the siblings may take place in the room. If this is not desired, we ask the family to meet in the gallery on the 2nd floor, as long as no other patients are staying there.
- The **restaurant** is currently not available for visitors and patients.
- Visitors with **symptoms** of coronavirus infection are not allowed to visit patients. These are symptoms of, among other things, an acute respiratory disease (e.g. cough, sore throat, shortness of breath) with or without fever, feverish feeling or muscle pain as well as sudden loss of the sense of smell or taste.
