

RESTRICTED VISITING REGULATIONS

Please follow the visiting rules below:

- Patients with a stay of more than three nights may receive visits from the fourth day onwards. **One visitor per day from max. two households** is allowed. Visiting hours are limited to **60 minutes per visit and day**.
- Visitors are required to **wear a mask** - even in the patient's room. A mouth and nose protection is provided free of charge at the clinic entrance. Fabric masks are not allowed.
- Each visitor must fill in his or her **personal information** on a form in the patient's room and hand it out to the nursing staff.
- Parents of **children under the age of 16** may visit at any time, provided the patient is in a single room or in a shared room with other children under the age of 16.
- Patients in **palliative situations** are allowed to receive named persons for visit from the first day. The visiting hours and the number of visitors will be arranged individually.
- The **restaurant** is currently not available for visitors and patients.
- Visitors with **symptoms** of coronavirus infection are not allowed to visit patients. These are symptoms of, among other things, an acute respiratory disease (e.g. cough, sore throat, shortness of breath) with or without fever, feverish feeling or muscle pain as well as sudden loss of the sense of smell or taste.
