

PLEASE ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING VISITING RULES

- All patients are allowed to receive visitors from the first day of their stay in our hospital. A **maximum of two visitors per patient** during the **entire hospital stay**, each visitor **max. 60 minutes** per day. Only one visitor at a time per patient is allowed in shared rooms. Private patients in single rooms may receive both their visitors at the same time if they wish.
- **Masks must be worn** when entering the patient's room and during the stay in the patient's room. The mask must also be worn when accompanying the patient or in close contact with the patient outside the patient's room. Masks must be worn in both single and double rooms. Children 7 years and older are also required to wear a mask. Cloth masks are not permitted.
- **Parents of patients under 16 years of age** may visit at any time, provided the patient is in a single room or in a shared room with other children under 16 years of age.
- Patients in **palliative situations** may receive visitors from the first day onward. The visiting hours as well as the number of visitors will be established on an individual basis.
- Our **restaurant** is **open** to visitors and patients.
- Visitors with **Covid-19 symptoms** are **not allowed to visit** patients.
