

PLEASE ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING VISITING RULES

- Access to the clinic is only permitted for **visitors aged 16 years with a valid Covid certificate** (vaccinated, recovered, tested) or **a negative test result**.
- All patients are allowed to receive visitors from the first day of their stay in our hospital. A **maximum of two named visitors per patient** during the **entire hospital stay**, each visitor **max. 60 minutes** per day. Only one visitor at a time per patient is allowed in shared rooms. Private patients in single rooms may receive both their visitors at the same time if they wish.
- **Accompanying persons** who **stay overnight** are **tested with a rapid antigen test**. The test takes place regardless of the vaccination status or recovery status.
- **Wearing a mask in the hospital is mandatory** throughout the entire duration of the visit. Masks must be worn at all times in both single and double rooms. Children 7 years and older are also required to wear a mask. Cloth masks are not permitted.
- Each visitor must provide their **personal details** using a form in the patient's room and hand it in to the nursing staff.
- **Parents of patients under 16 years of age** may visit at any time, provided the patient is in a single room or in a shared room with other children under 16 years of age.
- Patients in **palliative situations** may receive designated visitors from the first day onward. The visiting hours as well as the number of visitors will be established on an individual basis.
- Our **restaurant** is currently closed to visitors and patients.
- Visitors with **Covid-19 symptoms** are not allowed to visit patients.
