

VISITING RULES DURING THE BIRTH AND POSTPARTUM CARE

- Access to the clinic is only permitted for **visitors aged 16 years with a valid Covid certificate** (vaccinated, recovered, tested) or a **negative test result**.
- A **partner/husband** may be present **during the birth** and can visit during **regular visiting hours**. **Siblings** are allowed to visit the mother and newborn after the birth. Children's visits are limited to a **maximum of two hours per day**. **Double room:** If the other occupant of the room agrees and a distance of 1.5 metres can be maintained, sibling visits may take place directly in the room. If this causes any inconvenience to the other occupant, we ask that the family meet in the gallery on the second floor, provided there are no other patients there.
- It is allowed to receive **1 additional named visitor per patient** from the first day of the stay during the entire hospital stay, maximal **60 minutes per day**. Only one visitor at a time per patient is allowed in double-room accommodations. Private patients in single rooms may receive all their visitors at the same time if they wish.
- **Accompanying persons** who **stay overnight** are tested with a **rapid antigen test**. The test takes place regardless of the vaccination status or recovery status.
- **Wearing a mask in the hospital is mandatory** throughout the **entire duration of the visit**. Masks must be worn at all times in both single and double rooms. Children 7 years and older are also required to wear a mask. Cloth masks are not permitted.
- Each visitor must provide **their personal details** (including those of their children) using a form in the patient's room and hand it in to the nursing staff.
- **Our restaurant** is currently closed to visitors and patients.
- Visitors with **Covid-19 symptoms** are not allowed to visit patients.
