

PLEASE ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING VISITING RULES

- All patients are allowed to receive visitors from the first day of their stay in our hospital. A maximum of **two visitors are allowed daily** for a **60-minute** visit each. Only one visitor at a time per patient is allowed in shared rooms. Private patients in single rooms may receive both their visitors at the same time if they wish.
- We recommend that visitors who have not been fully vaccinated or have not completely recovered from Covid-19 undergo a test beforehand. The test should not be older than 72 hours and can be self-administered or conducted at a testing centre.
- **Wearing a mask in the hospital is mandatory** throughout the entire duration of the visit. Masks must be worn at all times in both single and double rooms. Children 12 years and older are also required to wear a mask. We recommend that children between the ages of 6 and 12 wear a mask as well. Masks can be obtained at the entrance to the hospital at no extra charge. Cloth masks are not permitted.
- Each visitor must provide their **personal details** using a form in the patient's room and hand it in to the nursing staff.
- **Parents of patients under 16 years of age** may visit at any time, provided the patient is in a single room or in a shared room with other children under 16 years of age.
- Patients in **palliative situations** may receive designated visitors from the first day onward. The visiting hours as well as the number of visitors will be established on an individual basis.
- Our **restaurant** is currently closed to visitors and patients.
- Visitors with **Covid-19 symptoms** are not allowed to visit patients. These can include symptoms of acute respiratory illness (e.g. cough, sore throat, shortness of breath) with or without a fever, a fever or muscle pain, or the sudden loss of smell or taste.
