

VISITING RULES DURING THE BIRTH AND POSTPARTUM CARE

- A **partner/husband** may be present **during the birth** and can visit during **regular visiting hours**.
- **Siblings** are allowed to visit the mother and newborn after the birth. Children's visits are limited to a **maximum of two hours per day**.
Double room: If the other occupant of the room agrees and a distance of 1.5 metres can be maintained, sibling visits may take place directly in the room. If this causes any inconvenience to the other occupant, we ask that the family meet in the gallery on the second floor, provided there are no other patients there.
- Starting on the first day of a stay in our hospital, **one more visitor is allowed daily** for a **60-minute** visit in addition to the partner/husband and siblings. Only one visitor at a time per patient is allowed in double-room accommodations. Private patients in single rooms may receive all their visitors at the same time if they wish.
- We recommend that visitors who have not been fully vaccinated or have not completely recovered from Covid-19 undergo a test beforehand. The test should not be older than 72 hours and can be self-administered or conducted at a testing centre.
- **Wearing a mask in the hospital is mandatory** throughout the entire duration of the visit. Masks must be worn at all times in both single and double rooms. Children 12 years and older are also required to wear a mask. We recommend that children between the ages of 6 and 12 wear a mask as well. Masks can be obtained at the entrance to the hospital at no extra charge. Cloth masks are not permitted.
- Each visitor must provide **their personal details** (including those of their children) using a form in the patient's room and hand it in to the nursing staff.
- **Our restaurant** is currently closed to visitors and patients.
- Visitors with **Covid-19 symptoms** are not allowed to visit patients. These can include symptoms of acute respiratory illness (e.g. cough, sore throat, shortness of breath) with or without a fever, a fever or muscle pain, or the sudden loss of smell or taste.
