

RESTRICTED VISITING REGULATIONS

Please follow the visiting rules below:

- Patients with a stay of more than three nights may receive visits from the fourth day onwards. Two visitors per day are allowed. Visiting hours are limited to 60 minutes per visit and day.
- Each visitor must fill in his or her personal information on a form in the patient's room and hand it out to the nursing staff.
- Visitors are required to wear a mask - even in the patient's room. The mask may be removed when eating and drinking in the cafeteria. A mouth and nose protection is handed out.
- In the case of pregnant women, women in childbirth and women who have recently given birth, the partner may be present during the birth as well as visit according to the regular visiting hours. Siblings are welcome from the first day. Please note the separate regulation.
- Parents of children under the age of 16 may visit at any time, provided the patient is in a single room or in a shared room with other children under the age of 16.
- Patients in palliative situations are allowed to receive named persons for visit from the first day. The visiting hours and the number of visitors will be arranged individually.
- Visitors with symptoms of coronavirus infection are not allowed to visit patients. These are symptoms of, among other things, an acute respiratory disease (e.g. cough, sore throat, shortness of breath) with or without fever, feverish feeling or muscle pain as well as sudden loss of the sense of smell or taste.
